




# How to Upload Photos from Your Phone to Your Windows Laptop/PC


1. Connect your phone to your laptop or computer via a USB cable
2. If you're Windows-based, scroll all the way to the bottom to **This PC**
  - It may also appear as a D: drive or some other designation.
  - A good thing to do is look at what's under **This PC** *before* you use the USB cable to connect the phone to the laptop/PC. After you connect the two, you'll see what's there now that wasn't before.





3. Double-click on **Internal Storage**. It will likely display many folders. Look for the one that says **DCIM** (Data Center Infrastructure Management) and double-click to open. Then, double-click on **Camera**. If you have a lot of photos on your phone, it may take a minute or so to open.




- Find the photo you want to transfer to your laptop or computer and double-click to open it. It will open the image in your default photo application.



5. All the default photo apps are different, but this is the one that comes with the current version of Windows. Click on **Edit** to access the image and then go to **Save Options, Save As Copy**.



6. Navigate to the folder where you want to save the photo on your laptop or computer, give it a name, and click on **Save**.



7. Your photo will now be on your computer where you saved it and available to use as you wish.
